



## No-show policy

A no-show is defined as the case that a regstree to an activity<sup>1</sup> organized by SVTN “J.D. van der Waals” is not present without any form of notification sent to the board or the organizing committee 24 hours before the start of the activity. Cases in which the participant has subscribed for the activity less than 24 hours before the start of the activity are excluded from the no-show policy. In that case, the no-show policy does not apply.

1. In the case of a no-show of an ordinary member, the member whom it concerns is not allowed to attend the next three recreational activities<sup>2</sup>. These three recreational activities cannot be open for registration yet, or must not have registration at all, and must take place within four weeks from the no-show<sup>3</sup>. If this is not possible, the member whom it concerns is not allowed to attend the first recreational activity which is not open for registration, or has no registration at all, outside those four weeks.
2. In the case of a no-show to a career related activity of a student that is not an ordinary member of SVTN “J.D. van der Waals”, the student whom it concerns is not allowed to attend the next three career related activities. These three activities cannot be open for registration yet, or must not have registration at all, and must take place within four weeks from the no-show. If this is not possible, the student whom it concerns is not allowed to attend the first career related activity which is not open for registration, or has no registration at all, outside those four weeks.
3. In the case of a no-show to a non-career related activity of a student that is not an ordinary member of SVTN “J.D. van der Waals”, the student whom it concerns will not be excluded from any activities.

These activities will be determined by the board. The person in question will be put on a blacklist for these activities.

For no-shows, the board has to ensure that:

- Every regstree for an activity will receive at least one confirmation before the final registration and deregistration date.
- When registering for an activity, it will be clear how and with whom the regstree could deregister.
- Every member of the board is informed who is currently on the black list. This way the policy can be properly executed.

First year members of SVTN “J.D. van der Waals” are excluded from this policy. For these members, a ‘two strikes and you’re out system’ is implemented. This means that for a

member who is in his/her first year one no-show will be condoned. For all no-shows after that, the policy described above will be upheld.

All registrees must pay the activity contribution in case of a no-show.

The no-show policy does not apply for cancellations with a valid reason. What is a valid reason is to be decided by the board.

The board will always have the right to differ from the policy above for special cases.
